1. About us

Thank you for visiting www.lppi.co.uk. This website is operated by Local Pensions Partnership Investments Ltd (“LPPi”), a company registered in England with company number 09835244. You can contact us using the details provided in section 5 below.

We use cookies, local storage, and tags to ensure that our website functions properly, improve your online experience, collect data to allow us and our partners to analyse website traffic.

2. What are cookies, pixels, tags and other technologies?

Cookies

Cookies are small text files deployed by a website that are stored in your browser directory or in the hard drive of your computer or mobile device so they can be retrieved by the website at a later date. Such storage allows the website to communicate with your browser directory or hard drive to allow us to present certain website functionalities to you, remember your preferences and carry out certain other functions.

Cookies are used to perform many different roles, and the purposes for which we use them are set out in the tables below. Some cookies (known as “session cookies”) are created temporarily and are deleted when you leave our website. Other cookies (known as “persistent cookies”) remain on your device for a certain period of time before expiring to allow your device to be recognised by, and communicate with, our website when you subsequently visit it.

Local Storage

Local storage is a technology that allows us to store data in your web browser and such data will remain in your web browser even once you leave our website and close your browser.

Tags

Tags are small pieces of software code, often provided by a third party (such as an advertising network), that are incorporated into our website. Tags will collect data (which may include personal data) about your use of our website, and share it with the third party that provided the tag. Collection of data in this way can be used to present personalised adverts and marketing to you and track the effectiveness of that marketing.

Personal Data

Cookies, pixels, local storage, social plug-ins and tags may be used to collect personal data or be combined with other information we hold to create personal data, regarding your interactions with our website, and this personal data may be shared with our partners.

Where we refer to N/A in final column of the tables below, this means that it is our Privacy Notice that applies to the processing of any personal collected via such cookie.

Where we refer in this Cookies Notice to personal data, we are referring to information relating to or about you.

3. What cookies do we use on our website?

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are necessary for our website to function and are always enabled (because our website won't work properly without them). They are usually set in response to actions you take such as filling forms. You can change your browser settings to switch these cookies off or alert you about these cookies (see further information below) but some, or all, of our website may then not work under those circumstances. These cookies do not store any personal data.

Accessibility cookies	The accessibility cookies remember the settings you selected, such as the text size. If you have sight problems the text resizer allows you to increase or decrease the font size – the cookie enables us to remember this setting. Analytical and Statistical Cookies

These cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors to our website so we can measure and improve the performance of our website when they are using it. They help us to know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around our website so we can make adjustments to improve user experience. These cookies may allocate a unique identifier to you so we can distinguish you from other users of our website whilst you are browsing our website.
